INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE

National

1 in 4 (27.4%) women were victims of contact sexual violence, physical violence, and/or stalking by an intimate partner with a negative impact (such as injury, fear, concern for safety, needing services, etc.)

1 in 9 (11%) men were victims of contact sexual violence, physical violence, and/or stalking by an intimate partner with a negative impact (such as injury, fear, concern for safety, needing services, etc.)

Delaware

1 in 4 (28.6%) women were victims of contact sexual violence, physical violence, and/or stalking by an intimate partner with a negative impact (such as injury, fear, concern for safety, needing services, etc.)

- Most prevalent impacts reported among women who experienced IPV:
 - 64.4% - Fearful
 - 62.4% - Concerned for safety
 - 58.5% - Any PTSD symptoms

1 in 12 (8.5%) men were victims of contact sexual violence, physical violence, and/or stalking by an intimate partner with a negative impact (such as injury, fear, concern for safety, needing services, etc.)

- Note: data estimates on impact types not statistically reliable to report data for men

Around 27,000 Delaware women (7.6%) experienced IPV in the last year (note: data estimates not statistically reliable to report data for men).

STALKING

National

1 in 6 (15.8%) women experienced stalking during their lifetime

1 in 19 (5.3%) men experienced stalking during their lifetime

Delaware

1 in 7 (13.7%) women report being stalked during their lifetime (note: data estimates not statistically reliable to report data for men)

SEXUAL VIOLENCE

National

1 in 3 (36.3%) women experienced some form of sexual violence in their lifetime

1 in 6 (17.1%) men experienced some form of sexual violence in their lifetime

Delaware

1 in 3 (33.6%) women experienced sexual violence during their lifetime

1 in 7 (14.8%) of men experienced sexual violence during their lifetime
