Domestic violence is a pattern of abusive behavior. In a relationship where abuse occurs, one partner tries to maintain control over the other by using physical, psychological, verbal, and/or sexual violence. Although factors such as drug and alcohol use, stress, or a family history of abuse may contribute to the problem, domestic violence is primarily an issue of power and control.

Domestic violence happens in lesbian, gay, bisexual, transsexual, transgender and straight communities. It crosses all social, ethnic, racial and economic lines. An individual's size, strength, politics or personality does not determine whether he or she could be considered a batterer.

Order of Protection From Abuse

In 2007 the State of Delaware expanded the Order of Protection From Abuse to include lesbian/gay victims, as well as all victims of dating violence who are or were involved in a substantive dating relationships.

A PFA is a civil action issued by Delaware's Family Court ordering someone to stop abusing another person and may also include other relief, such as ordering the abuser to stay away from the person being abused. A PFA is a way to get legal protection without pressing criminal charges against a partner or family member.
