

REPRODUCTIVE COERCION

Reproductive coercion is a form of power and control where one partner strips the other of the ability to control their own reproductive system and timeline. It can be difficult to identify reproductive coercion because other forms of abuse are often occurring simultaneously.

PREGNANCY PRESSURE & COERCION

Forcing a partner to terminate a pregnancy

Forcing a partner to carry a pregnancy to term

Threatening
harm to a
partner who
does not agree
to become
pregnant

Injuring a partner in a way that may cause a miscarriage

CONTRACEPTIVE SABOTAGE

Withholding hiding or destroying contraceptive

Intentionally breaking or poking holes in condoms

Not withdrawing when agreed upon Removing IUD's, contraceptive patches, and vaginal rings

SEXUAL COERCION

Repeatedly pressuring a partner to have sex Threatening to end a relationship if the person does not have sex

Forcing sex without a contraceptive Intentionally exposing a partner to a STI
