Maite S. Aros has over 32 years of experience advocating for survivors of domestic violence. She earned a five-year bachelor's degree in social work from the Pontifical Catholic University of Chile and immigrated to the United States in 1989. Maite began her work in the U.S. as a residential counselor at a domestic violence shelter, later serving as a shelter manager and bilingual case manager.

She has held multiple roles at CHILD, Inc., including Parenting Education Instructor (2003–2024) and Batterers Intervention Program Group Facilitator (2013–present), where she works to break cycles of abuse through accountability and education. For the past six and a half years, she has served as the Community Health Advocate Coordinator, supporting victims with trauma-informed care and connecting them to health, legal, and social services.

Maite is deeply committed to advocating for underserved communities, with a strong focus on women's rights, immigrant rights, and LGBTQ+ rights. She is a member of the Delaware Community Health Workers Association Coordinating Council, the DVCC Immigration Subcommittee, and the LGBTQ+ Subcommittee of the Victims' Rights Task Force. She earned her Delaware Coalition Against Domestic Violence (DCADV) certification in 2005.

In recognition of her dedication and impact, Maite received the Elaine Aviola Memorial Award for Outstanding Professional in 2018.
